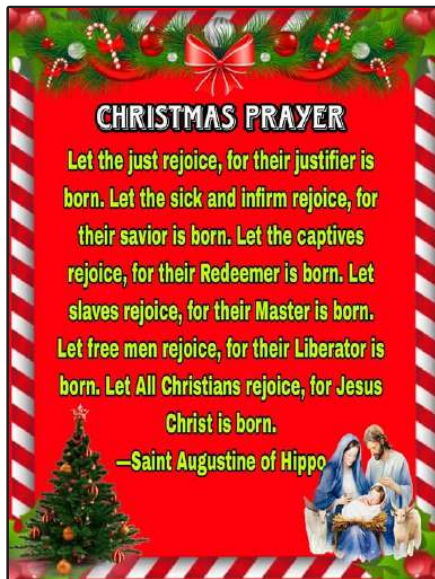
Editor's Column
